

Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

Dining Hall, Meals: Our Dining Hall has been set up with tables distanced 6' away and the tables have been reduced to half seating, so 4 people instead of 8. Our kitchen team will be replacing the utensils periodically during the meal service and hand sanitizer is available for use by all guests before they pick up their plate and start through the line and self serve. We will sanitize the dining hall after every meal which includes the usual wiping down of tables, the buffet line, and beverage island with a covid approved disinfectant and sanitizing the chairs at the tables. When multiple groups are joining meals, we will have the tables labeled so that each group is sitting at the same tables each time and not mixing with the other groups. We have 2 breakout spaces beside the dining hall that could also be used to separate groups. The kitchen staff will also be wearing masks when in the kitchen preparing, serving, and cleaning up. Our Food Service Director is also certified to serve from the COVID-19 SERVE SAFE course.

Facility: We will disinfect several times a day the commonly touched surfaces throughout the facilities. Door knobs and bars, light switches, sink faucets, toilet flushers, countertops, etc. Hand sanitizer is available in the Lobby as well for use as needed.

Lodging/Conference Room: The Hotel Rooms/Cottages/Dorms are cleaned with approved disinfectants as well as the conference room surfaces after each guest group use has ended before another group arrives. It is up to the group leader to determine how they want to set up the conference room according to their comfort level and with current guidelines in mind. RGC is not required to mandate that, it is up to the group leader, although we can be helpful as needed with suggestions on arrangements.

Sanitizing All sanitizers are CDC approved. We are following state mandates and guidelines laid out before us from the federal, state, and local officials. We will continue to seek guidance from the American Camp Association, Christian Camp and Conference Association, and local health agencies.

Guests We also ask, as is recommended nearly everywhere right now, that guests who aren't feeling well or who have been knowingly exposed to covid refrain from coming to camp to help in reducing the spread of germs and the virus.
